Prayer of the Five Wounds of the Savior



(The Prayer of Holy Russian Elder Isidore of Gethsemane Hermitage and how he taught his spiritual children to pray)

Turning one's face towards the icon of the Savior, say:

Placing the hand on the *forehead*, say:

"LORD, Thou Who art crowned with thorns upon Thy head, to blood and marrow, for the sake of my sins;"

Lowering the hand to the *right foot*, say:

"JESUS, whose right foot was pierced with an iron nail for the sake of my sins;"

Placing the hand on the *left foot*, say:

"CHRIST, Whose left foot was pierced with an iron nail for the sake of my sins;"

Raising the hand to the right shoulder, say:

"SON, Whose right hand was pierced with an iron nail for the sake of my sins;"

Transferring the hand to the left shoulder, say:

"OF GOD, Whose left hand was pierced for the sake of my sins; and Whose side was punctured by a spear; from Whose side flowed blood and water for the redemption and salvation of our souls;"

"Through the prayers of the most Holy Theotokos, grant me understanding."

Turning one's face towards the icon of the Mother of God, say:

"And through thee, most Holy Theotokos, through thy soul the weapon pierced, so that from many hearts will be revealed a spring of the repentant, thankful and heartfelt tears of all mankind."

(The initial words from each line of this prayer comprise the first phrase of the ancient Jesus Prayer: "Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner.")
